Habitat Acquisition and Preservation

GHAS has acquired over 3,000 acres of sensitive wildlife habitat for protection and preservation.

Conservation

In collaboration with Audubon Washington and other chapters, GHAS keeps abreast of local, regional and national conservation issues such as clean air, water quality, wetland and habitat protection and preservation.

Chapter Activities

- Bi-monthly programs for members and the public on a wide range of birding and conservation topics
- Periodic birding field trips
- Publication of newsletter, *The Sandpiper*, with articles about birds, habitat, conservation, advocacy and upcoming events
- Sponsor the annual Grays Harbor Shorebird Festival held during spring migration
- Support projects to enhance the Grays Harbor National Wildlife Refuge at Bowerman Basin in Hoquiam

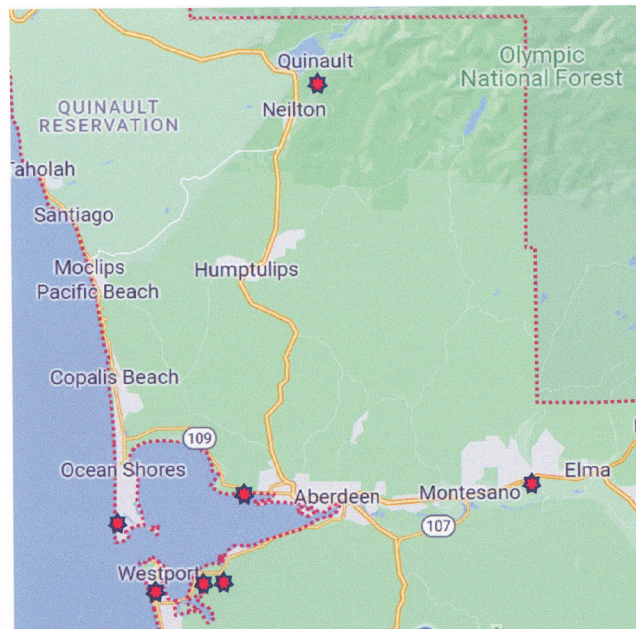
